

ROBLOX PARENTAL CONTROLS

Link to your child and set the limits, step by step

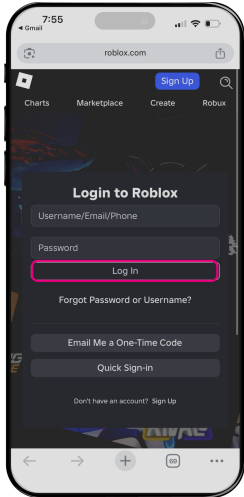
This links your verified parent account to your child's Roblox account, then sets their content level and turns off chat with strangers. Roblox calls the link Family Pairing. Do the parent account guide first if you have not set up and verified your own account yet. About ten minutes, free, and the game still works when you are done.

BEFORE YOU START

You need your own verified Roblox account, your child's account details, and a government ID. To link to a child, Roblox asks for an ID, not just the camera age check, because the bar to manage a child's account is higher. After verifying, Roblox does not keep your ID unless you allow it. In each picture, the pink box shows exactly where to tap.

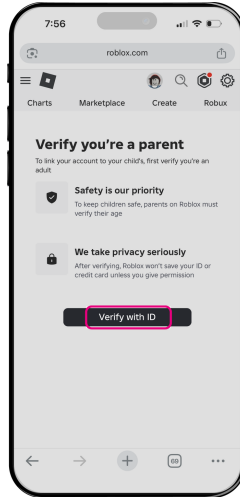
Layer 1 of the Castle Model, the controls inside each game and console.

LOG IN AND START



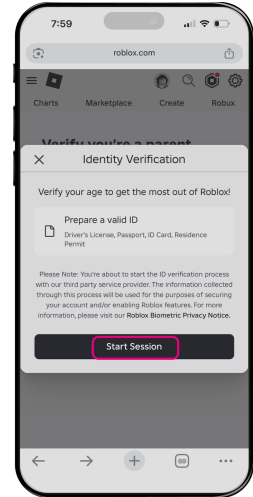
STEP 1

Log in to your own parent account at roblox.com.



STEP 2

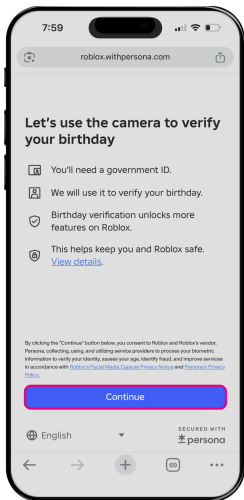
To link to your child, Roblox checks you are an adult. Tap Verify with ID. This is a stronger check than the account age scan, it needs a government ID.



STEP 3

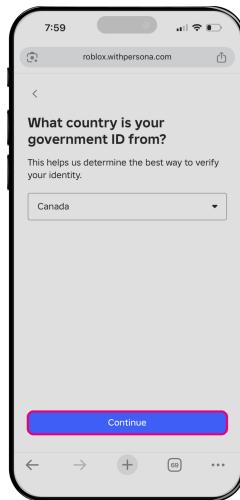
Tap Start Session to begin the ID check.

VERIFY YOU ARE AN ADULT WITH ID



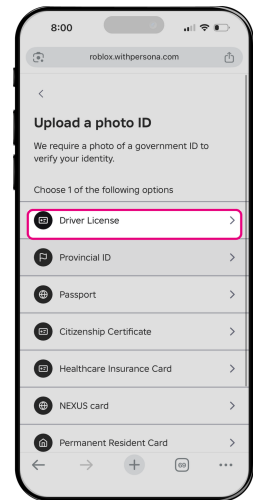
STEP 4

You will need a government ID for this step. Tap Continue.



STEP 5

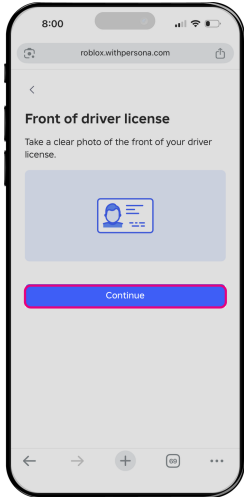
Choose the country your ID is from, then tap Continue.



STEP 6

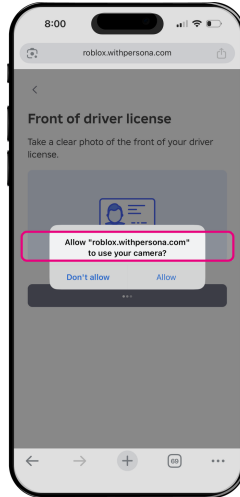
Pick the type of ID you have, for example Driver License.

VERIFY YOU ARE AN ADULT WITH ID (CONTINUED)



STEP 7

Tap Continue, then take a clear photo of the front of your ID.



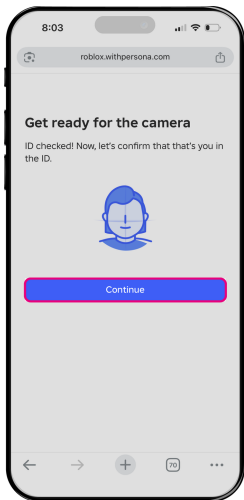
STEP 8

Tap Allow so the camera can take the photo.



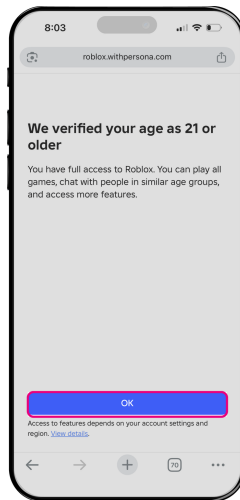
STEP 9

Roblox checks your ID. This takes a few seconds.



STEP 10

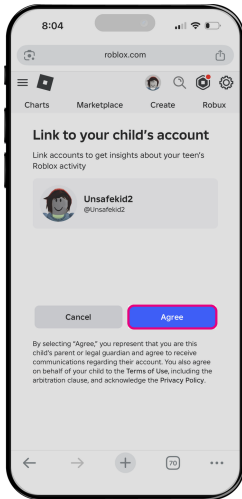
Now tap Continue and take a quick selfie so it can match your face to the ID.



STEP 11

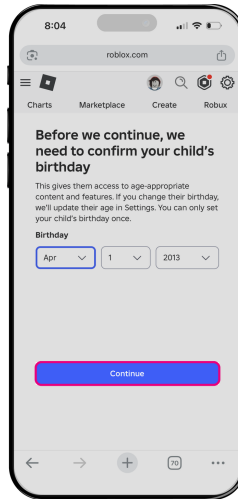
You are verified as an adult. Tap OK.

LINK TO YOUR CHILD



STEP 12

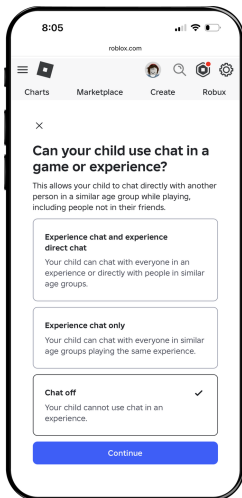
Confirm this is your child account, then tap Agree.



STEP 13

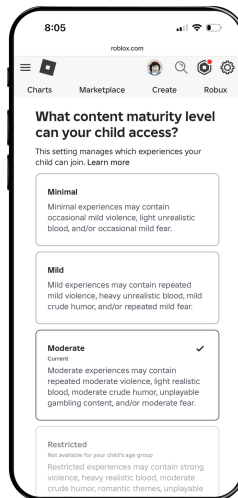
Set your child real birthday, then tap Continue. You can only set this once.

SET THE LIMITS



STEP 14

Choose Chat off to stop strangers messaging your child, then tap Continue. The game still works.



STEP 15

Set the content level to match your child age. For younger kids, Minimal or Mild is plenty. Moderate and Restricted allow more violence and mature themes.

That is the Roblox controls done. Your account is now linked to your child's, their content is matched to their age, and strangers cannot chat with them. The game still works.

WHAT THIS CATCHES, AND WHAT IT DOES NOT

These controls cover Roblox on every device your child plays it on: phone, tablet, console, or computer. They do not limit how long the game is played, set that on the device or in your home router, our Screen Time and HomeShield guides cover it. Content level and chat are the two settings that matter most: matched content and chat off shuts down the main path for stranger contact.

CHECK IT WORKED

From your child's account, try to chat with someone who is not a friend: it should be blocked. From your own phone, the parent dashboard should now show your child and let you change these settings any time.

KEEP GOING

This is one layer of five. Add the device controls (Apple Screen Time or Google Family Link) and your home router so the whole house is covered, and put the Safe Family Internet decal in your window so other families know they are not doing this alone.
